The Project Propeller Program, established by the Australian Institute of Project Management (AIPM), is a unique opportunity for aspiring project managers, students, and early-career professionals to advance their careers in project management.

By providing essential resources and opportunities for growth, the scholarship program aims to cultivate the next generation of project management leaders.

1. Objectives

- 1.1. **Professional Development:** To facilitate the professional growth of emerging project professionals through access to essential resources and certification.
- 1.2. **Networking Opportunities:** To provide recipients with opportunities to connect with industry professionals and peers at the annual conference.
- 1.3. **Recognition and Encouragement:** To recognise and encourage promising individuals who show potential in the field of project management.

2. Scholarship Package Details

- 2.1. Name: Project Propeller Program
- 2.2. Purpose: Project Management Professional Development Scholarship
- 2.3. Package Includes:
 - 2.3.1. One-year AIPM membership providing access to industry resources, networking events, and educational materials.
 - 2.3.2. Coverage of RegPM™ certification assessment fees enabling recipients to obtain a recognised project management certification.
 - 2.3.3. Full conference ticket to the 2025 AIPM conference offering opportunities to learn from industry leaders, attend workshops, and network with peers.
- 2.4. Number of Packages Available: Two (2)

3. Eligibility Criteria

- 3.1. Academic and Professional Requirements: Applicants must be enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program related to project management or be early-career professionals with less than 5 years of experience in the field.
- 3.2. **Commitment to Project Management:** Demonstrated interest in project management through coursework, internships, or professional experience.
- 3.3. **Statement:** Submission of a 500-word statement on the importance of the AIPM RegPMTM certification and continuous professional development in project management.
- 3.4. **Recommendation Letter:** One letter of recommendation from a faculty member, employer, or industry professional familiar with the applicant's qualifications.





4. Selection Process

- 4.1. **Application Submission:** Applicants must submit their completed application forms, statements, and recommendation letters by the specified deadline.
- 4.2. **Review Committee:** A scholarship review committee will evaluate the applications based on the established criteria.
- 4.3. **Interviews:** Shortlisted candidates may be invited for an interview to further assess their qualifications and suitability for the scholarship.
- 4.4. **Announcement:** The scholarship recipients may be featured in the AIPM's newsletter and website.

5. Application Process

- 5.1. **Application Form:** Complete the Scholarship Application Form available on the AIPM's website.
- 5.2. **Statement Submission:** Write and submit a 500-word statement on the given topic together with the application form.
- 5.3. **Recommendation Letter:** Obtain and submit one letter of recommendation with the application.
- 5.4. **Deadline:** All application materials must be submitted by the specified deadline.

6.2. Application Deadline: 30 April 2025
6.3. Review Period: 1-31 May 2025

6.4. **Announcement of Recipients:** June 2025
